

Intergraf Young Talent Award

Intergraf, the European Federation for Print and Digital Communication, has decided to support young people in the printing industry by inspiring them to work on relevant topics for our industry. One grant per year will be given to the selected student, apprentice or young worker from one of the member countries of Intergraf. The applications are open for young people below 25 who study print media or related subjects, train or work in the printing industry.

2022 Award Topic:

- 1. How do you see print products (graphics and packaging) in the circular economy?
- 2. What is your vision for print for a sustainable future?

Intergraf will grant the Intergraf Young Talent Award, a prize of EUR 3,000, to one person (student, apprentice or young worker) per year who will be selected from the applications based on the description of a 2-5 page summary. In case a presentation at the "Print Matters for the Future Conference" is an option for the winner, Intergraf will also cover travel and accommodation costs for the conference participation in Stockholm on Friday May 20, 2022.

Application Procedure:

The applicant is required to draft a 2-5 page summary of his/her work in English and can supply any other visual support he/she deems necessary to present his/her idea.

Availability for a presentation of the idea at our "Print Matters for the Future Conference" which will be held in Stockholm on May 20, 2022 is desirable, but not essential to win the Award.

Intergraf will select from amongst the received applications the most interesting and relevant application that should be shared with representatives from printing associations, printing companies as well as suppliers of the industry.
